The Kevin Bushell Foundation created this Memorial Scholarship to commemorate Electronic Technician 1st Class Petty Officer Kevin S. Bushell of the United States Navy. Kevin grew up in Gaithersburg and was an alumnus of Gaithersburg High School. ET1 Bushell tragically lost his life along with nine other USN sailors, when his ship, the USS John S. McCain, collided with an oil tanker just east of the Malacca Strait on August 21, 2017. The Kevin Bushell Foundation was formed to positively impact the lives of others, while keeping Kevin’s legacy alive. In ET1 Bushell’s short life he enjoyed learning, traveling, and serving his country. We hope that in applying for this scholarship, applicants will keep the sacrifice that Kevin, and so many others, have made serving their country at the forefront of their heart and mind.

This scholarship is open to all Gaithersburg High School Students planning to enter a 4-year college or university, regardless of military background or intent. The ideal candidate will embody the high ambition of achieving their educational goals to pursue their dream career, and to “Live the Kev life” - positively impact the lives of others. The Kevin Bushell Foundation will award one scholarship this year in the amount of \$3,000.
